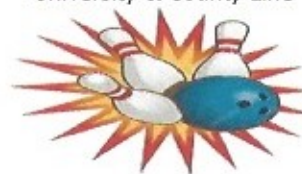

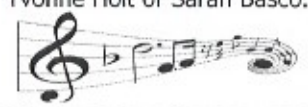

Making a Difference in Tough Situations Nehemiah 2:10-20

God is looking for those who will make a difference in the difficult places of life. Nehemiah shows us how this could be you.

- Do you see possibilities more than you see problems?
- Are you willing to courageously accept a difficult challenge?
- Do you have faith to believe that God can really use you?

1. Handling opposition when it comes your way (v.10)
2. Gathering all the facts before you begin (vv.11-16)
3. Getting people to do what they ought to do because they want to do it (vv.17-20)
